

Guidelines for UG/PG Online End Semester/Trimester Theory Examination June/July 2020

- All UG and PG students (Regular and Supplementary) will be having the End Semester Examinations during June/July 2020 in the online mode.
- The online End Semester Examinations will be conducted through the Kristu Jayanti Examination LMS.
- The general guidelines and login credentials regarding the online End Semester Examination will be shared to you shortly through the Kristu Jayanti College email id. Students are reminded to check the login of your college mail id and in case of any discrepancy intimate the system admin by email to onlineexam@kristujayanti.com or before 6th June 2020

- The online End Semester Examinations will be conducted through Two Components (Component I and Component II)

Online End Semester Examination June/July 2020 – Component I

- Questions shall be open for answering in the KJC Examination LMS from **15th June 2020**.
- Answers are to be submitted online through KJC Examination LMS on or before **25th June 2020**
- Questions shall be from the Units of the Syllabus which were not included for the Mid Term Examination. Syllabus shall be shared to you by 8th June 2020.
- Students can refer the books/reference materials or web content for answering the questions of Component I
- Answers of questions under Component I will be “**Descriptive**” in nature.
- Courses where answers include diagrams or mathematical/statistical/financial calculations shall be hand written and scanned as a single pdf file and submitted in the KJC Examination LMS.
- Courses where answers include only alphanumeric text have to be keyed in the text box provided in the Kristu Jayanti Examination LMS.

Online End Semester Examination – Component II

- **Online End Semester Examination (Component II) will have two parts**
 - **Part I – Descriptive Answer Questions**
 - **Part II – Multiple Choice Questions**
- Syllabus for Part I and Part II will be the syllabus used for Mid Term Examination. Syllabus for online Component II End Semester Examination shall be shared to you by 8th June 2020.
- Online End Semester Examination (Component II – Parts I & II) will commence from **2nd July 2020**.
- Time Table for Component II online End Semester Examination will be shared to you by 10th June 2020.
- In order to appear for the online End Semester Examination students should be in the proper grooming and hair cut (as in the photograph of college Identity Card) as image/video verification may be done during the online examination.
- According to the nature of the course Component II online examination may include both Parts I & II or Part I alone. The list of courses and the nature of the course shall be shared to you shortly through Kristu Jayanti email id.
