KRISTU JAYANTI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (KJSS)

(UG PROGRAMMES)

KJSS was instituted to motivate and encourage the students who are outstanding in academics, co-curricular & extra-curricular activities and to help the students who are financially backward. KJSS has three categories.

- a. Jayantian Achievement Scholarship (JAS)
- b. Jayantian Talent Scholarship (JTS)
- c. Jayantian Upliftment Scholarship (JUS)

The details are provided on the college notice board. Eligible students can obtain the application form at Counter No. 1 (UG Office). The duly filled form along with the supporting documents have to be submitted in the same counter on or before 13th February 2016.

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KRISTU JAYANTI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (KJSS) – for all UG Programmes

KJSS aims to recognize the students who are outstanding in academics, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and to help the students who are financially disadvantaged. KJSS has three categories:

- i) Jayantian Achievement Scholarship (JAS)
- ii) Jayantian Talent Scholarship (JTS)
- iii) Jayantian Upliftment Scholarship (JUS)

General Guidelines

1. Students who satisfy the stipulated conditions of the schemes are eligible under KJSS and are required to apply by filling up the form along with supporting documents within the due date
2. A committee will scrutinize the forms and the Principal will approve the beneficiaries under KJSS
3. KJSS is applicable only to under-graduate students
4. The scholarships will not be disbursed if there are no eligible students
5. The scholarships will be provided at the end of the academic year during a special function
6. Students who would qualify under category (iii. JUS) are also eligible to get scholarships under category (i) & (ii) provided they fulfill the conditions
7. The decision of the committee in identifying the beneficiaries will be final.
8. The number of scholarships and the amount disbursed each year will be decided by the Management of the College.
9. The minimum conditions for applying for scholarship does not guarantee award of scholarship.

1. Jayantian Achievement Scholarship (JAS)

Conditions

- 1.1 This scholarship is exclusively awarded for students who are excellent in academics
- 1.2 Students' academic excellence will be evaluated each semester on a continuous basis and students will be selected for this scholarship from II semester (after evaluation of performance in Semester I)
- 1.3 Students should have minimum 85% of attendance in each course in the previous semester(s)
- 1.4 B.Com./BBM students should secure minimum 75% of marks (aggregate of CIA & End Semester Examinations), BA & B.Sc. (CSMS/CSME) – 75% & B.Sc. (Life Science) / BCA –80%
- 1.5 Each eligible student will receive Rs. 10000/-

2. Jayantian Talent Scholarship (JTS)

Conditions

- 2.1 This scholarship is provided for encouraging students to excel in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities (Literary & Cultural, Sports & Games and any other special / unique achievement)
- 2.2 Students should have minimum 85% of attendance in each course in the previous semester
- 2.3 Students should secure minimum 60% of marks (aggregate of CIA & End Semester Examinations) and should have passed in all the courses
- 2.4 Students should have represented the college and won a prize at the University level/State Level / National level competitions.
- 2.5 Each eligible student will be awarded Rs. 10,000 in that academic year and an additional amount of Rs. 5000 will be given if the same student satisfies the conditions in the following academic year

3. Jayantian Upliftment Scholarship (JUS)

Conditions

- 3.1 This scholarship is provided to financially disadvantaged students
- 3.2 The annual family income of the applicant should be equal to or less than rupees one lakh
- 3.3 Applicants should have secured minimum 60% of marks (aggregate of CIA & End Semester Examinations) and should have passed in all the courses
- 3.4 Applicants should have minimum 85% of attendance in each course in the previous semester
- 3.5 A committee will scrutinize the application after an interview with the applicant where he / she has to justify the need for scholarship
- 3.6 Applicants have to produce a certificate pertaining to proof of income given by the local civil authority
