

M.Sc. (Psychology)

Psychology is the study of mental processes and human behavior by observing, interpreting, and documenting how individuals search for patterns that could help them have an understanding and anticipation of behavior making use of scientific techniques, concepts and procedures.

Course Design

The M. Sc. Psychology course is a two year full time programme in four semesters affiliated to Bangalore University and recognized by the Govt. of Karnataka. The course in M.Sc. Psychology will help students inculcate in-depth knowledge of various aspects of human behavior and its applicability in the various situations in life .

Eligibility

B.A. / B.Sc. degree from Bangalore University or any other university equivalent thereto with 50% marks (45% for SC & ST) in all the three options individually and aggregate and Psychology as a compulsory subject.
