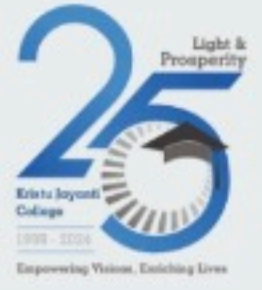

The institution developed Asses – Access – Action as an e-quiz for undergraduate and graduate students, to evaluate their overall knowledge about the 2030 Agenda.
