In recognition of its consistent pursuit of quality and innovation, Kristu Jayanti has been conferred the status of Deemed to be University under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, by the Government of India on July 8, 2025. With this milestone, the institution gains greater autonomy in curriculum design, interdisciplinary research, and societal engagement. It was reaccredited with an grade by NAAC in 2021, ranked 60th in NIRF 2024, and holds international accreditation from ACBSP (USA). The institution is also a DBT Star College and recipient of the National Clean and Smart Campus Award. In the India Today–MDRA Best Colleges Survey 2025, Kristu Jayanti was named the Best Emerging College of the Century in Commerce, Science, Arts, and Social Work.
