- To discuss the application and adaptability of third wave psychotherapies across diverse populations, including children, adolescents, the elderly, individuals with chronic illnesses, and marginalized communities
- To promote interdisciplinary collaboration in advancing mental health interventions

The seminar will bring together academicians, mental health professionals, policymakers, and industry leaders to engage in meaningful dialogue. It will provide practical knowledge and critical perspectives on the use of third wave psychotherapies to address the evolving mental health needs of individuals
