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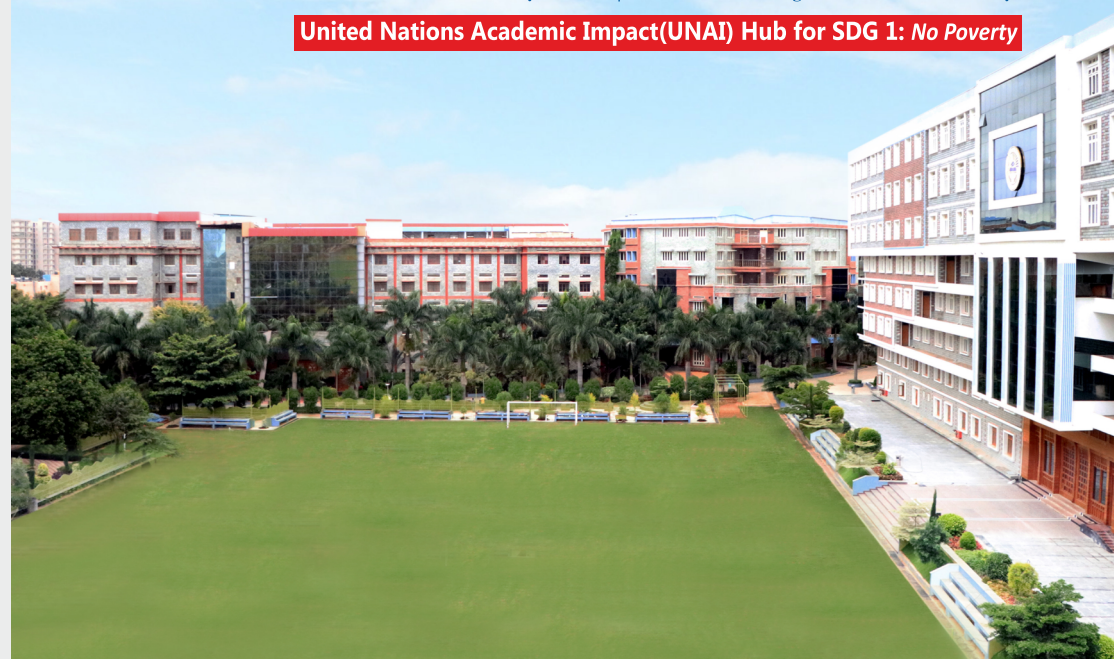

- Full paper should not exceed 4000 words
- References must be in APA 6th Edition reference style

- Selected papers will be published with an additional charges in reputed journals with ISSN and in conference proceeding with ISBN.
