



Brief write up of the Programme:







Number of beneficiaries: CSA volunteers & Purushanahalli village **Objective:**

- To execute and spread United Nation Sustainable Development Goal-1 among Students.
- To help the students to explore the world of the rural environment.
- To develop the students Interpersonal Skills.
- To inculcate social service behavior towards rural communities.

Brief Write up of the Programme:

Centre for Social Activities of Kristu Jayanti College is proud to organize the Rural Exposure Camp in Purushanahalli village, Doddaballapura Taluk, Bengaluru from 06/12/2018 to 09/12/2018. The objective of the camp is to enable students to understand the socio-economic and cultural conditions of rural life and to help students integrate essential values for life. The Theme of the camp is UN-SDG-1 "No poverty". According to the United Nations, "Eradicating poverty in all its forms remains one of the greatest challenges facing humanity. In the spirit of eradicating poverty, some of the important activities that have been planned in the camp are as follows: Swachh Bharat/ Shramadhan, life skills training, e-Banking awareness, awareness on Mudra Yojana Scheme, career guidance, to name a few. Selected volunteers belonging to the CSA club will be accompanied by staff. It is hoped that the camp will bring about significant changes in the selected rural locality as well as make a positive contribution towards SDG-1 -'No poverty'.

Day 1 (06.12.2018)

The Inauguration: Rural Exposure camp was inaugurated by the School Headmaster Mr. Shiva Prakash and it was attended by Mr. Ramesh Achar, Kannada teacher. During the inaugural speech



the Chief Guest appreciated the efforts of CSA to organize a rural exposure camp and commented on the fruitful social activities that the camp is going to implement in the rural area.

Life Skill Program

Next event of the day was a life skill program for school children organized by CSA volunteers. Effective communication, coping with stress, critical thinking, creative thinking, empathy and sympathy were the skills taught by CSA volunteers to the school students. Introduction about each topic was given by the volunteer followed by the knowledge they possessed about that particular topic. Each volunteer interacted with the students by involving them in an activity related to the topic. Real life examples were given about the life skills for better understanding.

Sports and Games for School Children:

Throw ball and Volleyball matches were conducted for boys and girls, they were divided into separate two groups and matches were conducted for 15 minutes, the team with the highest score were declared winners and prizes were distributed later.

Socio-Economic Survey

CSA volunteers were divided into groups and were sent to two different villages, each group were given a certain set of questions (questions were related to the family income, facilities provided in the villages, about the facilities provided by government such as hospitals, women empowerment programs etc.). Students were actively involved with the villagers and completed the survey. The main aim of the survey is to know the drawback of the village and villagers and further improve the village by providing the facilities which would help and support further improvement.

DAY 2 [07/12/2018]

Shramadhan [Swachh Bharath]

Volunteers were divided into groups and were given a range of space to clean the unwanted plants in a grove. Volunteers actively participated and cleaned the entire place.

Literary Events

Pictionary, Quiz, Drawing, Storytelling and poetry competitions were conducted by the volunteers for the high school and the primary school students. Pictures were drawn on the board by volunteers, participants had to guess the theme of the picture, the person with the highest score was considered the winner. Drawing competition was conducted with the theme of nature, participants drew beautiful pictures, and the volunteers interacted with the students and encouraged



them to draw. In the story telling competition participants narrated the stories in Kannada language.

Guest Lecture:

Dr. Parmeshwar from Primary Health Centre, Holikunte, Doddaballapura Taluk held a talk for the school students as well as the volunteers about the facilities, social services provided to the poor people, and the services for the specially abled people by the Primary Health Centre. He continued by explaining the difference between the older generation and the present generation by narrating a small story which inspired the young minds. The moral of the story was "Service is Life". He also highlighted various ways to overcome poverty, disabilities, problems that we face in the present generation. Volunteers were encouraged and inspired by the words of the guest.

DAY 3 [08/12/2018]

Shramadhan and Yoga

Volunteers were divided into groups and were given a range of space to clean the unwanted plants in the school premises and clean the dust. Volunteers actively participated and cleaned the entire place which facilitated the children to play joyfully.

Prize Distribution

Prizes were distributed to all the students who actively took part in various sports, literary and cultural events conducted by the volunteers. As a token of appreciation students were given prizes for their active participation in the events and to the remaining students pencils, pens and chocolates were distributed by the volunteers.

Dairy Farm Visit

The students had an opportunity to view and understand the functioning of a dairy farm. The visit enabled the students to acquire knowledge about the various actuators, controllers, containers being currently used in a dairy farm.

Cultural Program

To entertain the villagers and CSA volunteers, a cultural program was conducted. CSA volunteers and alumni members performed different events like dance, singing, drama, mimicry etc.

Interactive Session

Alumni conducted an interactive session for the volunteers. The volunteers were divided into groups and had a game session which tested the unity, knowledge, ideas, awareness and social commitment of CSA Volunteers. This session was an eye opener for the CSA volunteers and it helped them to introspect their role as a CSA volunteer.










NSS volunteers clearing the waste around the school campus








Students clearing the dry waste in the neighborhood areas of Kothanur and K. Narayanapura














Objective of the Programme:
