## Annual Report 2020 - 21

Kristu Jayanti College, Autonomous, Bengaluru envisions the educational charism of the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI) driven by a quest for excellence articulated in the vision, mission, goals, and core values. In the 22<sup>st</sup> academic year of the institution, the college offers **28 Degree programmes, 14 Post Graduate programmes, 3 Post Graduate Diploma programmes and 4 research centres**. In the current academic year 2020-2021, three new Under Graduate programmes and one PG programme were introduced. The institution currently caters to 7685 **students** representing all the States and Union Territories with 52% of girl students and 32% students from Backward Classes.

### **Blended Teaching, Learning and Evaluation Methods 2020-2021**

The theme chosen for the academic year was *“Enriching Multidisciplinary Capabilities through Reskilling and Upskilling”*.

### **ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES 2020-2021**

The departments actively engaged the learners through **a total of 432** interactive and experiential learning programmes to empower students. The college had organized **19 International and National Conferences, 118 Lectures, 22 Workshops, 45 Experiential Learning Programmes, 42 Student Centric Fests and Programmes, 109 Industry Institute interactions, Tech Talks**. Ample learning opportunities were provided in the contemporary fields of expertise. **428 eminent scientists, academicians, industry experts** were invited to interact with students and Faculty members.

**Centre for Soft Skills Training, Centre for Employability and Corporate Relations, Institution Innovative Council and Kristu Jayanti Incubation Centres** have organised **77** Employability Enhancement / Skill Enhancement Coaching sessions. Training for students interested in CA, CPT, CS and Banking exams, IAS other Administrative Services exams, ACCA and CMA, NET/ SET coaching, and Foreign languages training [French, Japanese, Spanish and German language] were offered.

**The Centre for Life Skills Education (CLSE)** offered **Life skill training** to **2759 students** in this academic year. The college **counselling centre and guidance cell** with an in-house counsellor provided personal and professional guidance. The faculty members of the departments also served as academic mentors.

**59 Value Added Courses and Certificate Courses** were conducted to provide additional skill enhancement to all the students of the institution. The institution is also recognized as a nodal centre to conduct online courses offered by Swayam, IIRS-ISRO, Dehradun (Indian Institute of Remote Sensing) and has collaborated with Coursera to offer MOOC with 45000 licenses. 462 students completed 25 Open Online Courses offered by prestigious institutions including UGC Swayam.

To express student potential, talent, innovation and creativity, **32 Clubs and Associations** of the department had conducted **27 Fests and 312 Competitions** witnessing the **89%** participation of students.

**FACULTY ACHIEVEMENTS:** The faculty members of the college endeavor in grooming students' personality and inculcate a culture of lifelong learning for their success in career and life. In the current academic year, faculty members have published 10 patents, authored 25 books, 162 articles in Scopus and UGC Care indexed International Journals. 21 Faculty members had received awards for their outstanding contribution towards innovative teaching, research and extension services. 12 Research Projects were completed and 3 major projects are ongoing.

**JAYANTIAN EXTENSION SERVICES** organised 53 extension activities in this year providing pandemic relief and awareness, commemorating days of National Importance, awareness programmes on waste management, Save Water and Green campaigns. The student volunteers organized online observation of **Independence Day, World Environment Day, International Yoga Day, Cleanliness Campaigns**, Sampling Plantation, Distribution of Masks and Sanitizer in their neighborhood. Department of Social Work organised a week of Social Work Camp at Kannamangala in February 2021

**PLACEMENTS:** In the academic year, 26 companies have conducted online campus recruitment and 2 companies have conducted direct campus placements till date and 231 students have received offer letters [UG 112, PG- 119] with an average CTC of Rs.5.60 lakhs and highest CTC of Rs. 7 Lakhs.

646 students participated in the conferences and workshops, 265 papers were presented, 16 publications were made, 6 PG students completed NET exams and 4 students completed all papers in ACCA exams.
