Dr. Justin Nelson Michael, Member IQAC and Director, Centre for Research presented the status of the preparedness of the institution towards $3^{\text {rd }}$ cycle of NAAC accreditation. The activities in this regard starting from the formation of core committee and the status of the preparation till date. The college is planning to submit the IIQA in December 2020, and online SSR submission in January 2021.

## Agenda - 3 <br> Quality Initiatives of the Institution

Dr. Aloysius Edward, Co-ordinator of IQAC and Dean, Faculty of Commerce \& Management presented the quality initiatives of the institution with respect to Teaching Learning and Evaluation. Dr. Edward highlighted the use of Kristu Jayanti Learning Management System and the adoption of a learner centric approach in teaching, learning and evaluation in online mode. Dr. Edward informed the meeting that the pandemic has not stopped the institution from implementing any of its regular academic or co-curricular programmes. The college could conduct all do all the programmes through the online mode. Prof. Ravichandra Reddy appreciated the faculty members and the college for the innovative and diverse teaching learning methodologies. The details of research awards 2019-2020, and the statistics regarding research publications, patents filed and the Institution funded and Collaborative Community Project
were presented. The amount distributed through the various scholarship schemes and the initiation of Jayantian Determination Scholarship in 2020 - 2021 were highlighted.

The procedures in place in Kristu Jayanti Learning Management System and the orientation given to all students and faculty members regarding the online examinations were highlighted.

Mr.Vijayan appreciated the college on its seamless transition to technology enabled learning during the pandemic times which proved that Kristu Jayanti College is an institution with good data culture and technology orientation. Pandemic is a differentiator and the good data culture will help the institution not only in the NAAC accreditation process, but in many more avenues.

Fr. Principal explained the processes in place for online teaching and learning and evaluation and Kristu Jayanti College is in a position to help other institutions in the conduct of online examination from the gained experience.
Mr. Vijayan queried about the difficulties faced during online classes. Dr. Aloysius Edward was of the view that internet connectivity of students was a major hurdle and to some extent this could be overcome by the availability of the learning content available to the student in the learning management system Moodle.
Fr. Principal added that proper IT infrastructural augmentation was done for conducting classes and the class animators are regularly in touch with the students to addressing the difficulties faced by the students.
The external members enquired about the plans for the physical conduct of classes and the Principal the informed that the college is planning in bringing students to the campus in a phased manner giving priority to courses which are more practical oriented.

Ms, Kezia Sheriff, the alumni representative inquired about the institutional IT support mechanisms offered to students. Fr. Augustine George explained the distribution of laptops to deserving students and college computer labs being opened to students for learning and provisions made students opting for offline end semester examination. Arrangements are made to accommodate students in the college hostel in the event of students coming back to the campus.

Ms. Keziha queried about how proper engagement with students is happening in the online mode and what measures are in place to address the stress related issues of the students.

Mentoring is conducted and wellness hours were introduced to interact with the students and every department is connecting with the students through organizing fests and other academic enrichment activities. Dr. Aloysius Edward was of the view that much hard work is put up by the teachers to reach out to the students.

The student council secretaries appreciated the efficient conduct of online classes and the concern and availability of teachers for the students and the interesting academic content available in the learning management system.

The external members and the alumni member congratulated the college on the successful conduct of online classes and expressed that the pandemic period once again proved that only the fittest will survive.
