The Chairperson welcomed everybody and thanked all the members present for the guidance and support rendered by them for the growth of the institution. The principal highlighted the role of IQAC in the third cycle of assessment and accreditation by NAAC

Presentation of the agenda of the meeting

Dr. Aloysius Edward J, the Director of IQAC, presented the agenda for the meeting.

Agenda – 1

Approval of the meeting minutes held on 25th November, 2021

Dr. Aruna Devi K, Secretary, IQAC presented the minutes of the meeting held on 25th November, 2021. The summary highlights of the ATR based on the previous meeting was presented before the meeting. The minutes of the meeting and the action taken report was approved without any modifications.

Agenda - 2

Review of Quality Initiatives of IQAC

Dr. Aloysius Edward, Director of IQAC and Dean, Faculty of Commerce & Management presented the quality initiatives of IQAC. He explained about the thrust areas of quality enhancement in terms of benchmarks as Institutional Quality Improvement Benchmarks (IQIB). The institutional benchmarks include the areas of Faculty and Staff Development, Teacher Quality, Admission, Funds Allocation / Reflection in Financial Statements, Functional MoU, Maintenance of Registers, Green and Smart Campus and Centres / Association Level. The benchmarks pertaining to Curriculum, Teaching-learning, Research, Consultancy and Extension, Student Support and Progression and Human Values and Professional Ethics is defined at the department level. Teaching-learning, Research Output and Professional Enrichment benchmarks are also defined at teacher level. Dr. Edward listed the various refinements IQAC included in the areas of Teaching Learning Process which are Course Plan Preparation & Presentation, LMS Course Content Preparation, Learner Level Identification (AAA), Student Centric Teaching Learning Methods, Teaching Learning Pedagogy Repot and the Measures of CO-PO Attainment. Sir also discussed the new structure of Quality Audit

Process of Kristu Jayanti has its Department Quality Improvement Session (DQIS), Biannual Academic Audit (Department), Annual Academic & Administrative Audit (AAA) and Autonomy Committee Visit.

Agenda – 3

Submission of AOAR 2021 - 2022

Prof. Ramya B, Associate Director – IQAC, informed the members that the AQAR submitted for 2020-2021 was accepted by NAAC on 5th July 2022 without any remarks. 3899 students submitted the student satisfaction survey and the feedback on curriculum by the stakeholders are uploaded and available in the college website. Mam also informed that the AQAR of 2021 – 2022 to be submitted by January 2023.

Implementation of NEP 2020

Dr. Calistus Jude, Dean, Faculty of Sciences, presented the process of implementation of NEP at the institution and explained that the members that all the teachers, administrative staff and students of the institution have been oriented about NEP 2020. Expert Lecture on Role of Teachers in Implementing NEP 2020 in Colleges by Prof. Dr. B. Thimme Gowda [Vice Chairman, Karnataka State Higher Education Council Chairman, Committee on Curriculum Reforms in Higher Education, NEP 2020 Former Vice Chancellor, Bangalore University, Bengaluru], National seminar on 'Implementation of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 - A Roadmap was organized in association with by Bangalore North University on August 18, 2021, Virtual International Conference on Implementation of NEP 2020 In Higher Education Institutions: Opportunities and Challenges on December 1 and 2, 2020 were the three major programmes organized by the institution in this directive. Lot of Collaborative meetings with Prof. Dr. B. Thimme Gowda and Karnataka State Higher Education Council helped the institution in the implementation.

The College has implemented the curriculum framework suggested by the Karnataka State Higher Educational Council (KSHEC) based the recommendations of NEP 2020 for all the UG programmes from 2021 batch. Our faculty members are Nominated in the Curriculum Committee for KSHEC for implementing NEP. He also stated that all the UG programmes adopted NEP 2020.

Dr. Jude enumerated the various quality initiatives of IQAC namely
