The meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell with the external members for the academic year 2023 - 2024 was held on 17<sup>th</sup> November 2023. The meeting was held in Senate Hall, Administrative Block. The meeting was chaired by the Principal, Fr. Dr. Augustine George. The Chairperson extended welcome to everyone and acknowledged and expressed gratitude to all members for their guidance and support that has contributed to the institution's development.

#### Presentation of the agenda of the meeting

Dr. Aloysius Edward J, the Director of IQAC, presented the agenda for the meeting.

#### Agenda - 1

#### Approval of the meeting minutes held on 15th December 2022

Dr. Aruna Devi K, presented the minutes of the meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 and the summary highlights of the Action Taken Report. The minutes of the meeting and the action taken report were approved without any modifications.

#### Agenda - 2

#### **Review of Quality Initiatives of IQAC**

Dr. Aloysius Edward, Director of IQAC and Dean, Faculty of Commerce & Management presented the quality initiatives of IQAC. He started the presentation by mentioning that quality is a continuous journey towards excellence and Kristu Jayanti College is striving towards the sustenance of quality in all the ventures. The first quality initiative presented by Dr. Edward was the collaborative learning with the visit of major higher education institutions to Kristu Jayanti College for improving quality assurance activities. 20 educational institutions had visited the college in 2023, for discussing the best practices and quality processes of the institution.

Prof Edward detailed the formation of DQAC (Department Quality Assurance Cell) in this academic year to strengthen and equip the departments to ensure their quality journey and sustenance in the context of the quality manual for programme level envisioned in higher education. He also explained the structure and composition of DQAC, where the department's Head serves as the chairperson, and the committee comprises the DQAC convenor, as well as the documentation in charge from the department.



Another major quality venture is the conduct of DQIS meeting every semester wherein the progress of the department pertaining to all the quality parameters will be discussed and ensure that all the faculty members are getting involved in the functioning of the department.

The next quality initiative undertaken this year following the suggestion from the third cycle of NAAC accreditation was the establishment of CHIRD (Consortium of Higher Educational Institutions in Research and Development). The constituent colleges in this collaborative venture are St Aloysius College, Mangalore, PSGR Krishnammal College for Women, Coimbatore, and Stella Maris College, Chennai. Five major target areas were identified, and a finalized proposal has been crafted accordingly, outlining comprehensive strategies and plans for each area of focus.

Silver Jubilee Year Celebrations and Jubilee initiatives were also explained by Dr. Edward. He shared details about a few more milestones of the institution such as hosting of the Confederation of Indian Industries meeting and competitions, the 15<sup>th</sup> IQAC National Conference, the 8<sup>th</sup> Educator's Meet, Faculty Development Programmes and Bi-annual academic audit.

### Agenda – 3 Submission of AQAR 2022 - 2023

Prof. Ramya B, Associate Director, IQAC, presented details of the submission of AQAR for 2021-2022 and acceptance by NAAC on 17th June 2023. She also shared that the AQAR of 2022 – 2023 is to be submitted by March 2024.

Dr. Gopakumar A V, Dean, Faculty of Humanities, presented the scheduled programmes of IQAC. The 15th National IQAC Conference (I-Con) on Building Multidisciplinary and Transdisciplinary Capabilities in Higher Education is scheduled on March 16 & 17, 2024 and the 8<sup>th</sup> All India Educators Meet Fostering Transdisciplinary Capabilities through Transformative Education is planned on May 2 - 4, 2024. Annual Academic and Administrative Audit is another agenda of the year.

# Agenda – 6 Suggestions and comments

**Prof. A H Rajasab**, Former Vice Chancellor, Tumkur University appreciated the practice of bringing Industry experts as professors of Practice and recommended keeping these members on the Curriculum Advisory Committee and Board of Studies.

He provided suggestions for the institution to be actively engaging with the State Education Policy committee. He suggested the centre for research to consider applying the BRICS fellowship and proposed that CHIRD could spearhead its implementation. He proposed that, given the ongoing situation in Manipur, students from the region should be granted admission even if they are unable to provide the usual required credentials for admission.

He advocated that the institution should study the dropout rate of students and ensure that economic reasons do not lead to dropouts. The institution can encourage and facilitate the industry's support to cover students' educational expenses.

Fr. Dr. Augustine George provided details of various scholarship schemes of the college to help the needy.

Mr. Jayas Damodaran, Senior Director, Sales Force commended the practice of industry experts as professors of practice and expressed delight at being involved in this role as a professor of practice. He suggested aiming for a position below 100 in the upcoming NIRF survey. He also proposed establishing centers of excellence within the institution and recommended envisioning industry-collaborated centers to enhance collaboration between the institution and industry. He suggested initiating small projects involving students in collaboration with companies. He indicated the need and possibility of initiating an industry-specific portal. He also recommended organizing alumni talks similar to TED Talks. He emphasized the necessity of initiating more community service endeavors.

Fr. Dr. Augustine George provided details of the software development cell with plans to add more initiatives or projects in the future. Research is another area of focus and the constitution of CHIRD is for exploring new avenues in research. The establishment of a community school is one of the college's initiatives, aiming to expand its outreach and engagement with the local community.

Dr. Aloysius Edward provided details of extension initiatives such as the Integrity Stall and Compassion Corner, that promote voluntary student engagement in service aimed at reaching out to society. Additionally, these initiatives seek to instill a sense of responsibility and empathy within the student body towards the community.



Mr. Ivin George praised the college for excelling in hosting various programs and initiatives He suggested acknowledging and introducing a credit system to students involved in cultural or extension

activities.

Fr. Dr. Augustine George acknowledged the need of awarding credits and explained the rubrics designed in the institution for mapping the Skill Enhancement Courses by integrating students' involvement in cultural programs and extensions, thereby granting them academic credit.

Mr. Abin, the secretary of the student council, expressed his delight in witnessing the institution's achievements. He expressed gratitude to the college for fostering an environment where students have excellent accessibility to both the faculty and the management. Additionally, he appreciated the distinctive programmes offered by the college. He shared that the industry interaction program has been beneficial for student community.

Ms. Guda Divija Reddy submitted her sincere and heartfelt gratitude to all the teachers and management for their great efforts in bringing the college to greater heights. She expressed that the curriculum is meticulously structured to align with and fulfill the demands of the job market.

The meeting concluded with Dr. Justin Nelson Michael, Director of the Centre for Research, thanking all the members for their valuable efforts and contributions to Kristu Jayanti College's journey towards excellence.

He suggested that in light of programme-level accreditation requirements of the future, IQAC should strengthen departments and DQAC in documentation and monitoring and quality sustenance of the department. He proposed conducting training and reorientation sessions for the DQAC team deanery-wise.
