A STEP TOWARDS NEW LIFE

The students from the Department of Social Work, Kristu Jayanti College Autonomous, Bangalore, organised a Social Action Research Initiative named Project SANJEEVANI meaning "A new life, or a renewed life", which was led by Ms. Riya Shaji Mathew, and other members, Ms. Meghana, Ms Aleesha, Ms Catherine and Ms. Sania for the Koracha and Nayika Community settled in the area around TC Palya, Bangalore on the 26th of November, 2024. The students raised funds by themselves, which amounted

upto Rs. 100,000/- for this project. They prepared packets including some daily essentials (such as Rice, Dal, Oil, Brush, Paste and Soap) and some winter essentials (such as Blankets and sleeping mats) and distributed them among 35 families. This project was a small step towards bringing a smile on the faces of the people in the community and it was well-received by them.
