BENGALURU, DHNS: The Department of Life Sciences at Kristu Jayanti College (Autonomous) will host a panel discussion on November 5, spotlighting Nobel Prize-winning discoveries in Physiology and Medicine, including the groundbreaking contributions of 2024 laureates Dr Sarah Gilbert and Dr Albert Bourla in global health and scientific advancement.

This event is part of the college's 'Nobel Prize Lecture Series', where academic departments present panel discussions and lectures focused on the achievements of Nobel Prize winners.

The series was inaugu-

rated on October 10 by the Department of Physical Sciences with a lecture on the 2024 Nobel Prize in Physics, awarded to John J Hopfield and Geoffrey E Hinton for their pioneering work on artificial neural networks.
