Date: 29/6/2016 & 30/6/16

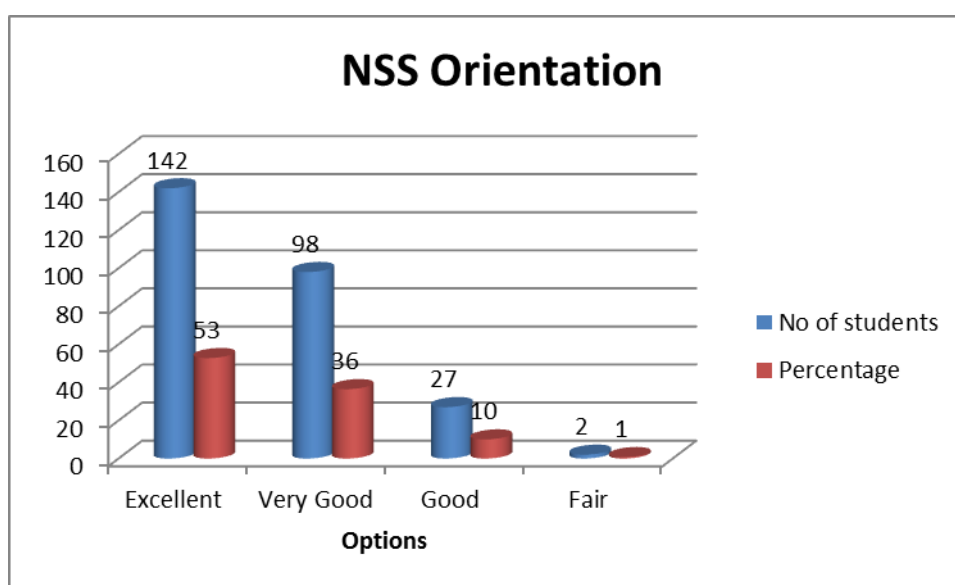
No Of Students Participated: 269

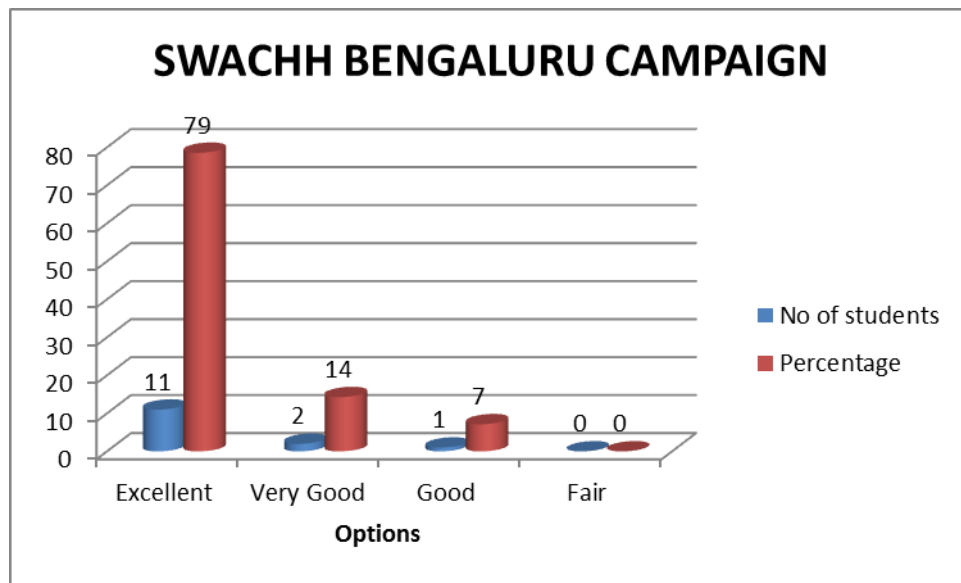

Objective: To make this campus free of plastic zone and other wastes.

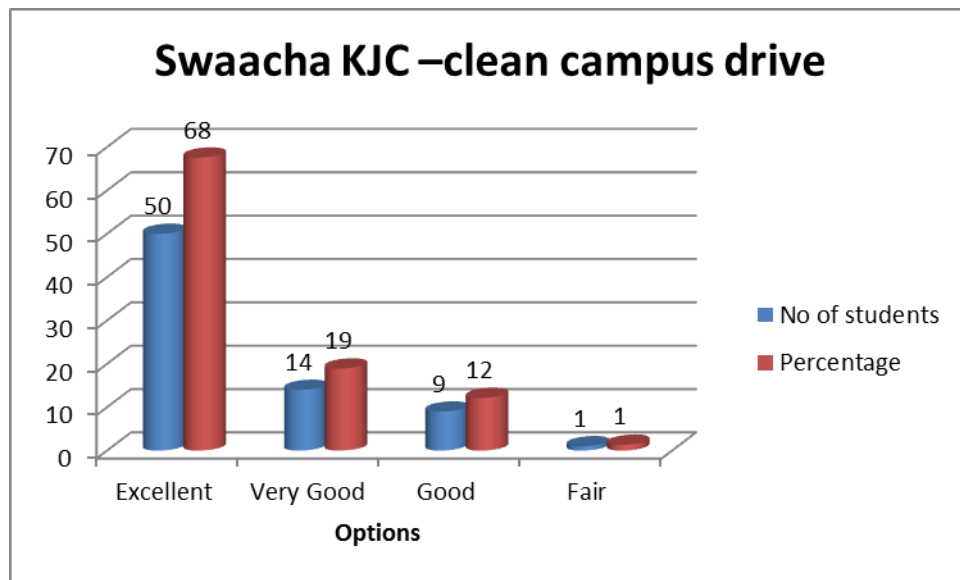

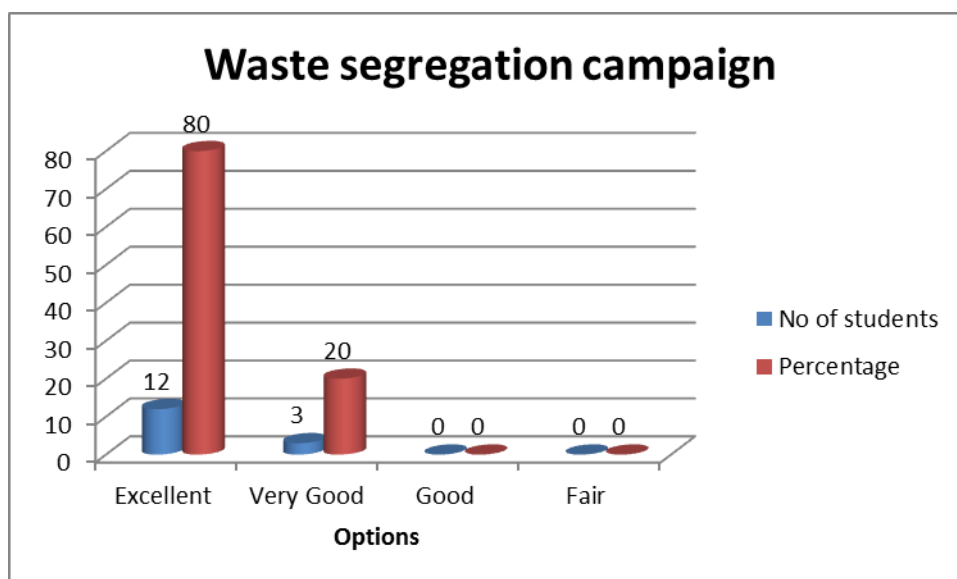

Objective: To inculcate the sense of responsiveness and belongingness in the minds of the students towards serving the needs of our society.

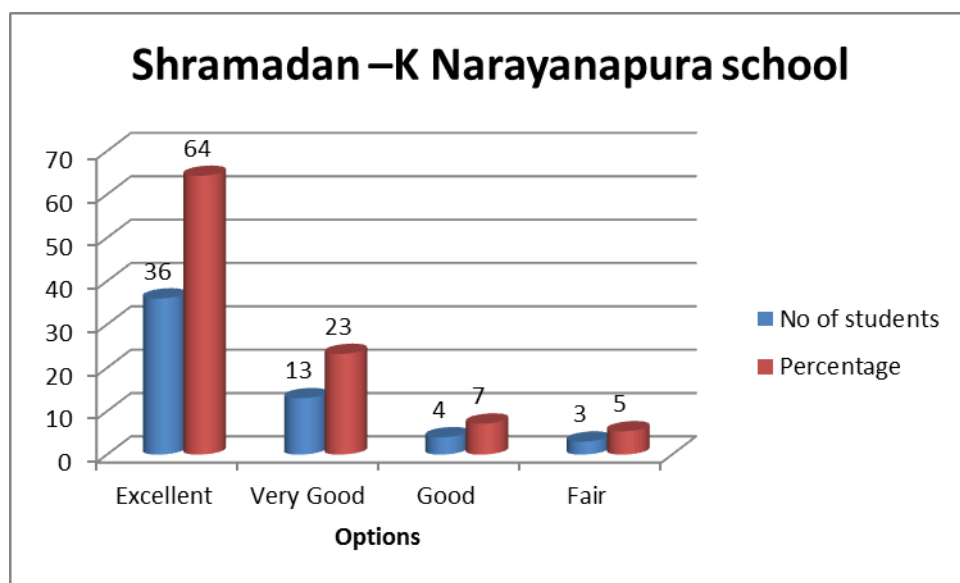

No of Students Participated: 51

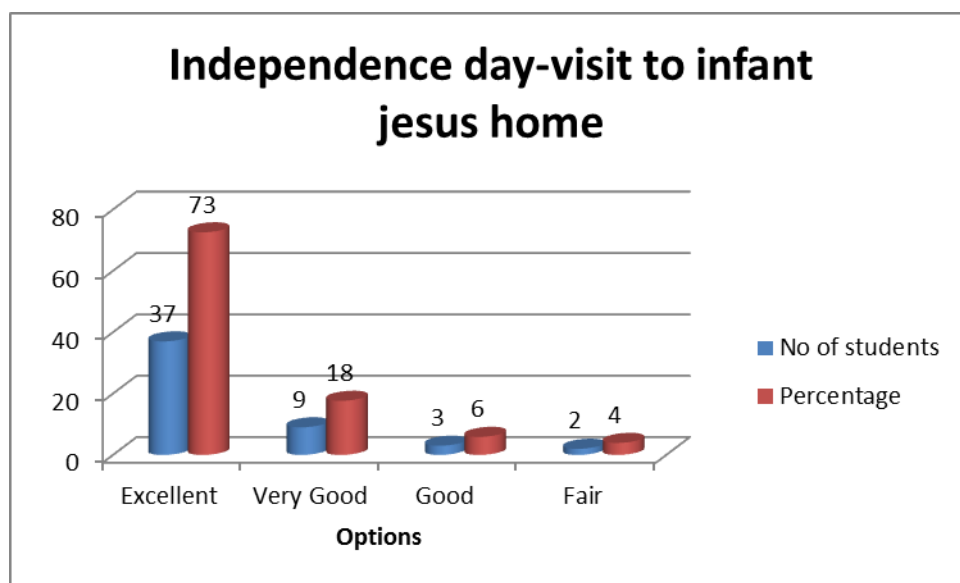
Objective: To pay tribute to the freedom fighters and to nourish the young children by offering them their needs and wants.

Objective: To create an awareness about dengue, its causes, symptoms and remedies

NSS unit of Kristu Jayanti College organized Dengue Awareness Campaign. The students were accompanied by the following staff coordinators Dr.Shreedhar Pd., Prof.Prathap, and Prof.Kalyani.

This awareness program was conducted in the neighbourhood villages which includes Narayanpura and Geddalahalli. The NSS volunteers took this opportunity to create awareness among the public about dengue and the Aedis Mosquito which causes the dengue. The students also showed them the “Larva” which emerges from the egg of Aedis Mosquito.

Students visited each house and especially slum areas and created consciousness among lots of People who were unaware of these Dengue situations and also informed them about the Dengue fever, its severe effects and how to tackle these situations in an easy simplified manner so that they could remain safe. The students also requested the people not to leave the water to get accumulated nearby their residences.

The campaign covered around 100 houses in the neighbourhood villages. This effort was highly appreciated by the public.



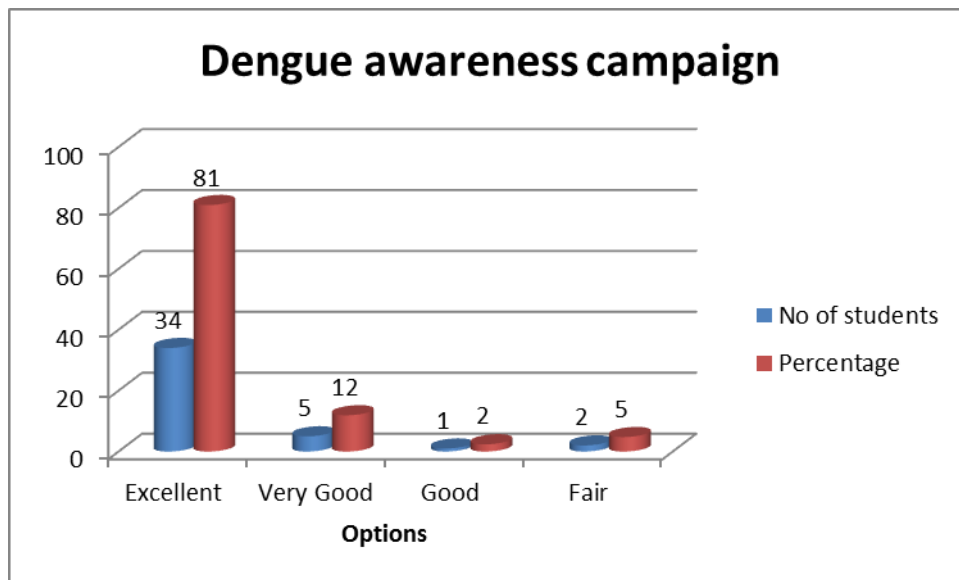

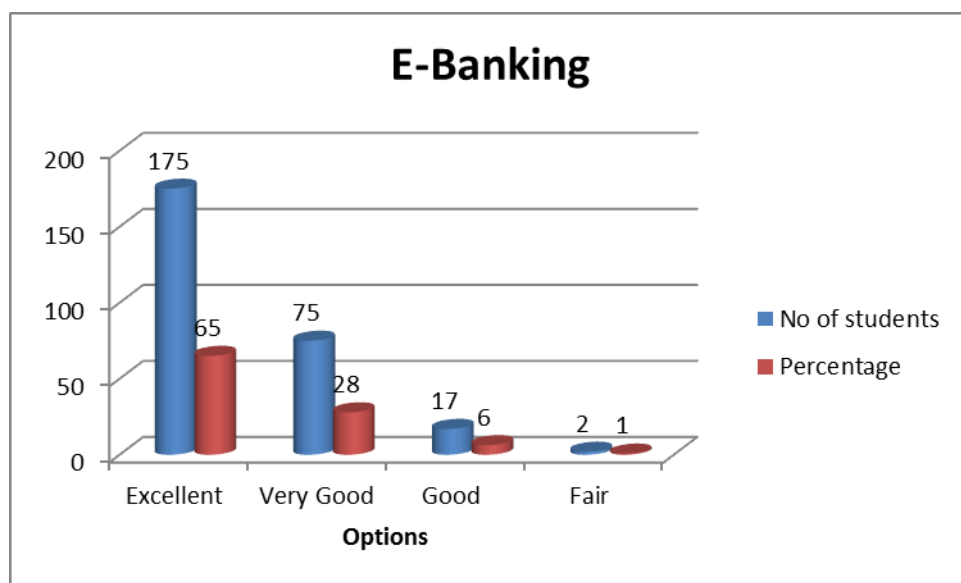

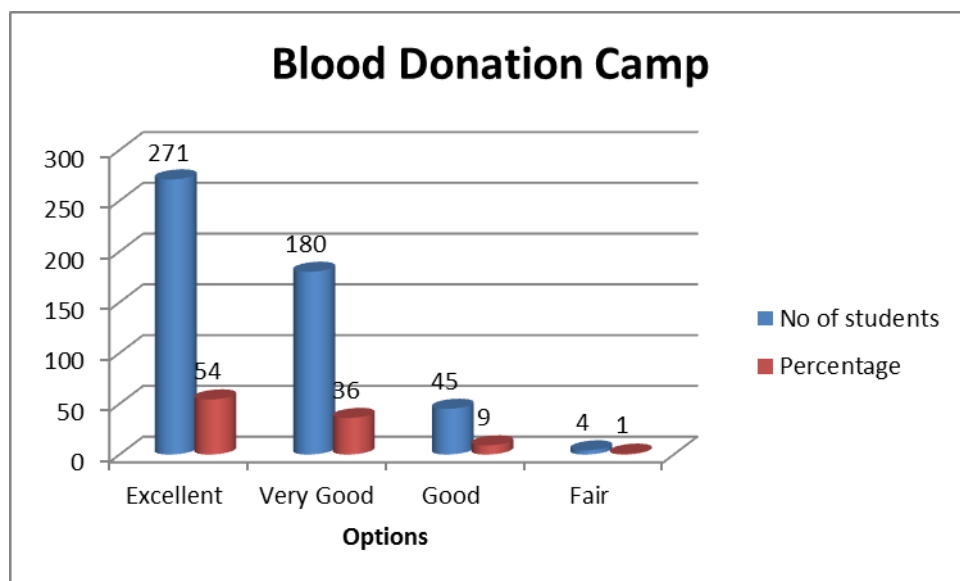

No Of Students Participated: 60 – 70

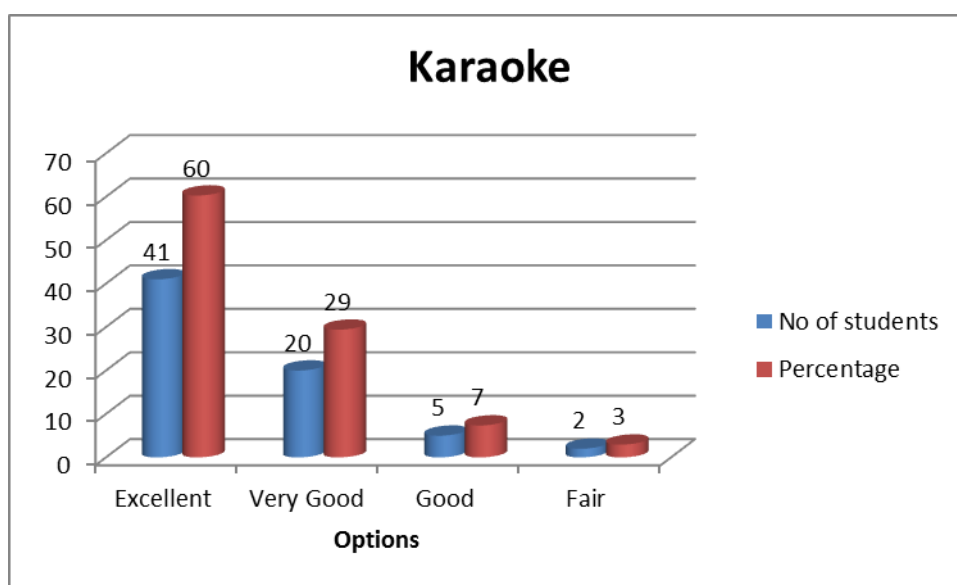

Objective: To create awareness among students of the NSS unit about the importance and usefulness of the Palm Leaf manuscripts and how to preserve it.

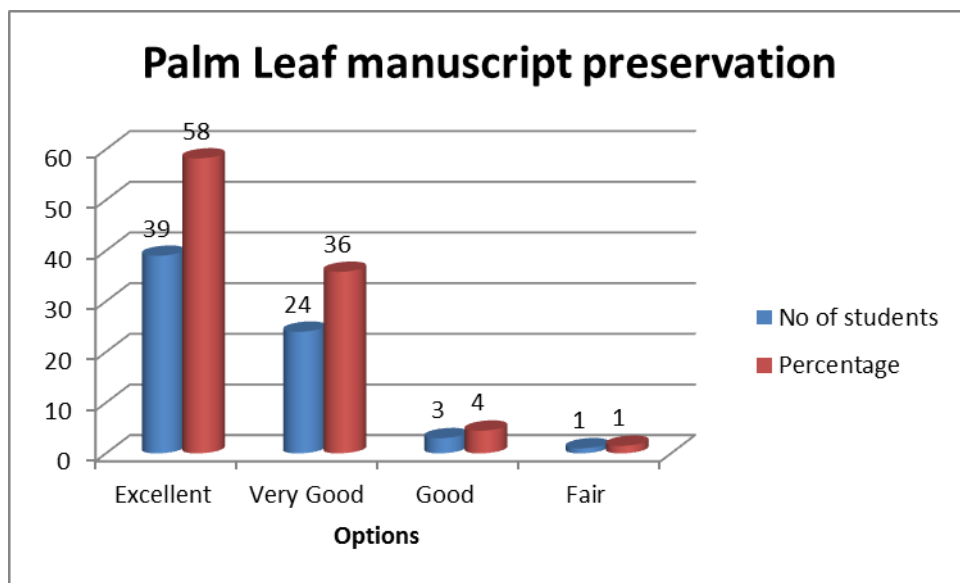

Objective: to create an awareness among students of the NSS unit about the importance and usefulness of electricity as well as why it is necessary to be careful when using electrical appliances.

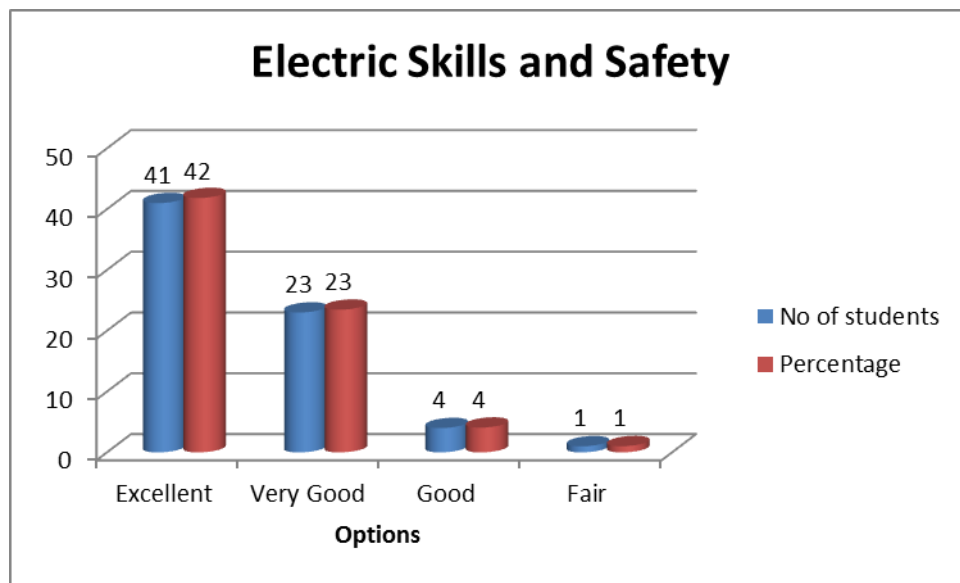

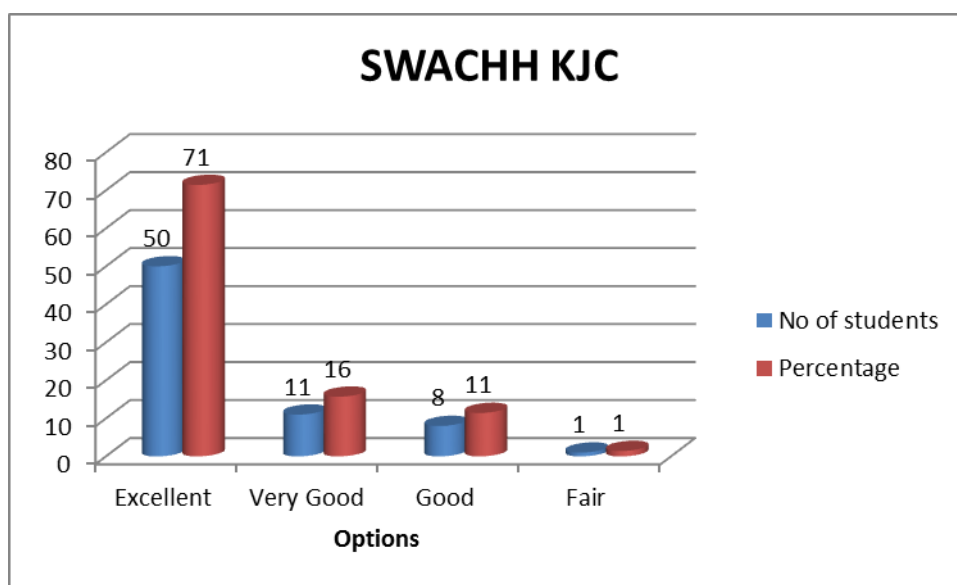

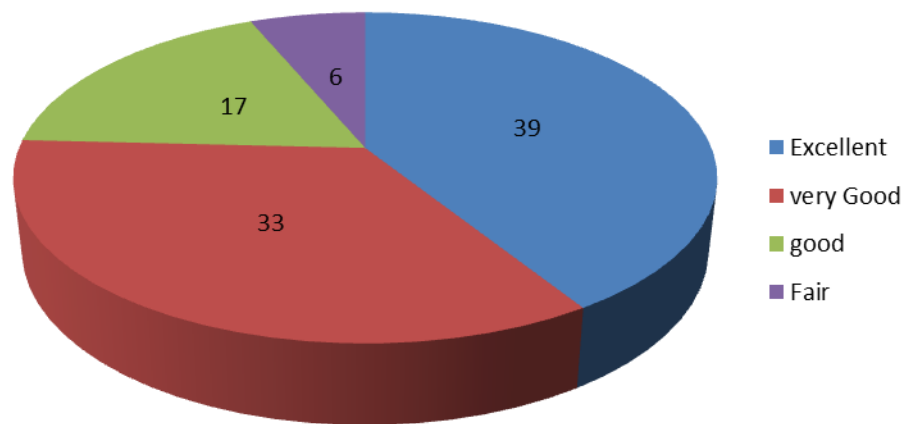
