#### LITERARY EVENTS

# CREATIVE WRITING (English, Kannada & Hindi)

- Individual Event
- Time limit : 1 Hour
- Topic will be given on the spot
- <u>Categories: Secular& Gospel(Gospel only in English)</u>
- The event will be conducted virtually (live)-the students will be monitored over zoom.
- The pdf of the creative writing to be uploaded in Google form.

# ELOCUTION (English, Kannada & Hindi)

- Individual Event
- Time limit: 2 minutes
- Topics will be announced on the college website and Kristu Jayanti + App one day prior to the event
- The event will be conducted virtually (live)-over zoom platform.

# QUIZ

- Two members per team
- Prelims will be conducted via Google Forms on 29<sup>th</sup> September (to be submitted individually).
- The finals will be conducted virtually over zoom platform.
- Rules / rounds will be given on the day of the event
- Categories: <u>General & Gospel</u>

# **DEBATE (English, Kannada, Hindi)**

- Two members per team
- Time limit: 6 minutes (3 min for each member)
- One member to speak for and one against the topic
- Topic will be announced on the college website and Kristu jayanti + App two days before the event
- The event will be conducted virtually (live)-over zoom platform.

#### PERSONALITY CONTEST

- Individual Event
- Event is compulsory for all final year student co-coordinators for academic clubs and associations
- A task will be given to the participants which should be uploaded within a given time limit.
- Detailed rules will be put up on the college website and Kristu jayanti + App one day prior to the competition.

#### MASTER OF CEREMONY (Can you Anchor?)

- Individual event
- Round 1: Pick and promote (Two minutes per person, promote an event, movie etc)
- Round 2: 60 seconds to fame (one minute per person, showcasing of talent)
- Round 3: Anchoring an event of Kalajyothi
- ✤ The event will be conducted virtually (live)-over zoom platform.

#### FINE ARTS

#### PENCIL SKETCHING

- Individual Event
- Time limit: 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> hours
- Theme will be given on the spot
- Participants have to Sketch on1/4 size chart paper
- The event will be conducted virtually over zoom platform. Once sketching completed participants need to upload photo in Google form.
- Categories: Secular & Gospel

#### PAPER PAINTING

- Individual Event
- Time limit: 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> hours
- Theme will be given on the spot
- Crayons are not allowed
- Participants have to paint on1/4 size chart paper
- The event will be conducted virtually over zoom platform. Once completed, participants need to upload the photo of the painting in the Google form.
- <u>Categories: Secular & Gospel</u>

#### CARTOONING

- Individual Event
- Time limit: 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> hours
- Theme will be given on the spot

- No colour to be used
- Participants can use 1/4 size chart paper
- The event will be conducted virtually over zoom platform. Once completed participants need to upload photo in Google form.

#### POSTER MAKING

- Individual event; Time limit: 1½ hours
- Theme will be given on the spot
- Participants have to prepare their poster. Once completed the participants have to upload in the Google form.
- Participants have to use on1/4 size chart paper.
- The event will be conducted virtually over zoom platform
- <u>Categories: Secular & Gospel</u>

#### COLLAGE

- Individual event
- Time limit: 1.5 hours; Topic will be given on the spot
- Participants will have to record the video of their performance for 2 minutes and upload video and picture of Collage in Google form.
- Participants have to use on1/4 size chart paper.
- No usage of paint, no burning paper, no writing, no usage of scissors

#### TRASH ART

- Individual event
- Time Limit: 1.5 hours
- Only trash or used / waste material should be used by participants
- Judgment will be based on creativity and effective utilization of trash
- Participants will have to record their process for 2 minutes.
- \*\*Process includes Showcasing the trash used, process of making the product and final Product.
- Upload video and picture of Trash Art in Google form.

#### **DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY**

- Individual Event
- Time limit : 1 hour (Same Day)
- Guidelines will be given one the same day of submission of photographs (Kindly do not miss it, if you are not present, your registration will stand as invalid)
- Colour or Black & White photo
- Only one photo should be submitted along with proof of originality (Geotag)
- Photo to be uploaded in Google form within the stipulated time.

#### **DOCUMENTARY VIDEO**

- Individual Event
- Time limit: Max 3 minutes
- Topic: (Will be announced)
- The documentary video should be original video graphed, edited and produced by the participant.
- The video should be shot only inside the premises of the participant; any scene shot in public will lead to disqualification.
- Video should be ready in MP4 format and uploaded to the Google drive (Instructions will be provided)

#### JEWELLERY DESIGN

- Individual event
- Time: 1 hour (Same Day)
- Participant can design the pattern of jewellery on 1/4<sup>rth</sup> size chart paper
- Participants should enable video and record **2 minutes** video of their performance and upload the video and photo of the final design in link provided by the organizers.

#### **COSTUME DESIGN**

- Individual event
- Time: 1 hour (Same Day)
- Participant can design the Costume  $on1/4^{rth}$  size chart paper.
- Pencil colours can be used
- Participants should enable video and record 2 minutes video of their performance and upload the video and photo of the final design in link provided by the organizers.

# NAIL ART

- Individual event
- Time limit: <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> hour (Same Day)

•Participants should enable video and record **2 minutes** video of their performance and Upload the video and photo of the final design in link provided by the organizer.

# RANGOLI

- Individual Event
- Time limit: 1 hour (Same Day)
- Glitter/ Chalk / Salt / Fire not to be used
- Only dotted rangoli is allowed measurement should be 16/16 dots
- Participants should enable video during the competition and upload a pic of the final design in the link provided by the Organizers.

- Participants should mention how many dots they have used in Rangoli.
- Criteria for judgement: Geometry, perfection, creativity, methodology

#### MONO ACT

- 1. Time: 3 minutes
- 2. Language : English, Hindi, Kannada
- 3. Should be based on a theme
- 4. Participant should enact TWO or more characters
- 5. The event will be conducted virtually over zoom platform
- 6. Categories: Secular & Gospel

#### MIMICRY

- 1. Time: 3 minutes.
- 2. Language should be English / Hindi / Kannada or Sounds mimicking natural or artificial events, machines, musical instruments, etc.
- 3. The event will be conducted virtually over zoom

# SOLO DANCE (EASTERN & WESTERN)

#### **Categories I. Eastern: (1) Classical (2) Indian II. Western Time limit: 5 minutes**

- 1. Medley music is allowed for Indian / Western
- 2. Medley/film music will not be accepted for Classical Dance category
- 3. Indian music will **not** be entertained for western category
- 4. Props are allowed
- 5. For the preliminary round participants should be ready with a 2 minute recorded video of the dance
- 6. The Video Quality should be good in which the Dancer and props need to be evident. In video recording light should be focused on the dancer.
- 7. Audio Quality should be good, preferably use Speakers while recording.
- 8. The audition video can be uploaded in the Google drive on or before 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2020.
- 9. Final round will be conducted virtually over zoom C

#### MUSIC

#### WESTERN VOCAL SOLO (Secular and Gospel) EASTERN VOCAL SOLO (Classical and Light Vocal)

- Students have to send a video recorded song
- Song can be either Western or Vernacular
- Song should be sung for minimum one minute and should not be more than 90 seconds
- Song should be originally recorded without the use of any app.
- Accompaniment of a musical instrument is allowed (without rhythm mode). Karaoke is not allowed.
- For eastern vocal solo classical shruti box or tampura volume should be low.
- Categories (for light vocal): Secular & Gospel
- Editing and cropping of videos are not allowed.
- The file should be uploaded in Mp4 format .
- The link should be copied and pasted onto the registration Google form that will be provided.
- Participants should upload videos to Google Drive before 23rd September.
- Participants should send the lyrics of the song beforehand itself along with the video, through google drive.
- Selected finalists will have to perform live through Zoom platform and must stick to the same song performed for the audition. Finals will be held on 3<sup>rd</sup> October2020.

#### BEATBOXING

- Individual event to test vocal percussion skills
- Time limit: 3 minutes
- Students have to send a video of them beatboxing.
- Any kind of musical instrument or voice modulating app is not allowed
- Editing and cropping of videos are not allowed.
- The file should be uploaded in Mp4 format.
- The link should be copied and pasted onto the registration Google form that will be provided.
- Video should be uploaded one day prior to the event.

#### **INSTRUMENTAL SOLO**

#### Categories: 1. Eastern 2. Western

- Time limit: 3 minutes
- One song or piece to be performed
- Synthesizer to be used in piano/organ mode (for western category only)
- Accompaniment is not allowed.
- Judgement will be separate for string, wind, keyboard and percussion instruments
- Competition will be conducted live through- Zoom Platform. Students will be put in the waiting list and one student at a time will be let in for the performance.

#### RAP

- Individual event
- Time limit: 3 minutes
- Submission of a copy of the lyrics to the jury is mandatory; Vulgarity will lead to disqualification.
- Participant should record a video of their performance.
- Editing and cropping of videos are not allowed.
- The file should be uploaded in Mp4 format.
- The link should be copied and pasted onto the registration Google form that will be provided.
- Video should be uploaded on 29<sup>th</sup> September prior to the event.
