## **Research Centre in Management**

The Doctoral Program (Ph. D.) in Management offered by Bengaluru North University, balances solid grounding in the fundamentals of the discipline with the flexibility to combine and create new knowledge that is derived from a doctoral student's research interest. Doctoral students are expected to pursue academically rigorous coursework and work independently on a research topic that develops and leads to the completion of a doctoral dissertation. Doctoral students are encouraged to develop original ideas, collaborate on research projects and present their work at major national and international conferences.

The College has full-fledged research centre to inculcate research capabilities among students, research scholars and teaching fraternity. Faculties are encouraged to take up government and non-government funded projects sponsored by agencies like ICSSR, UGC. Centre ensures timely completion of the projects in compliance with policies of sponsoring agency. Whenever required, the guidance on scientific and other procedures is extended to project directors. On periodic basis, the Centre organizes FDPs, workshops, seminars, and conferences of national/international repute to discuss issues and exchange innovative ideas on specific topic. The Centre is committed to build research integrity and extend need-specific training programs through state-of-art facilities of the institution.

A number of research papers have been published in national and international research journals and some of the research papers have appeared in journals with high impact factor. The college library has more than 30,000 commerce related books, 200 journals and 45000 + online journals and books for the purpose of carrying out the research. The department strongly believes that it will produce quality researchers in commerce and quality research work.

#### **Research Facilities**

- Kristu Jayanti College has 3 libraries Undergraduate Library, Post graduate Library and the Law Library.
- The libraries can accommodate more than 800 students and have facilities like internet and Wi-Fi services, symposium halls for group discussion, locker facility, computer lab, reprography facility, current affairs section etc.
- The library subscribes to electronic resources from J GATE, Springer, EBSCO, ProQuest, N-List, RMIT and other institutions for its students and faculty through IP access. The library activities are computerized and the catalogue is available online.

- The library is the heart of the institute. Libraries serve as centers of interdisciplinary places shared by learners from all disciplines.

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Pursuant to the resolution of the Syndicate at its meeting held on 04.09.2020 and in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 66 of the KSU Act 2000, the Bengaluru North University hereby accords provisional Recognition to Kristu Jayanthi College (Autonomous), Bangalore-077 as Research Centre for conducting research leading to Ph.D. programme in Management from the year 2019-20 to 2021-22 (Three Academic Years)subject to the following conditions:

- The Centre should follow the Regulations Governing Doctoral Degree Programme of the Bengaluru North University and Carry out the Ph.D. Programme as per the regulations as modified from time to time.
- A Research Advisory Committee (RAC) should be set up with the Chairperson of concerned P.G. Department of the University. The Committee should meet twice a year, preferably in May and November, so that progress reports of research students are scrutinized and forwarded through the committee.
- 3. The observation/conditions as laid down by the Expert Committee of the Bengaluru North University in their report have to be fulfilled, a compliance this regard shall be sent to the University within 15 days of the receipt of this notification
- The Centre should submit an undertaking in the enclosed proforma within 15 days of the receipt of this notification
- The Centre will have to pay the prescribed annual affiliation and other fees (for Ph.D. programme) to the Bengaluru North University and seek renewal of recognition once in three years.
- 6. Guest Temporary faculty of the Department are not eligible to guide students
