KRISTU JAYANTI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (KJSS) (UG PROGRAMMES)

- ❖ KJSS was instituted to motivate and encourage the students who are outstanding in academics, co-curricular & extra-curricular activities and to help the students who are financially backward. KJSS has three categories.
 - a. Jayantian Achievement Scholarship (JAS)
 - b. Jayantian Talent Scholarship (JTS)
 - c. Jayantian Upliftment Scholarship (JUS)
- ❖ Application forms for KJSS will be issued from 4th January 2020 to the eligible students upon producing supporting documents at Counter No. 1 (UG Office). The duly filled form along with the supporting documents should be submitted in counter No. 1 on or before 18/01/2020. Late submissions will not be entertained. Eligibility criteria and the general guidelines for availing the scholarship are displayed on the college notice board and the college website.

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KRISTU JAYANTI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (KJSS) – for all UG Programmes

KJSS aims to recognize the students who are outstanding in academics, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and to help the students who are financially disadvantaged. KJSS has three categories:

- i) Jayantian Achievement Scholarship (JAS)
- ii) Jayantian Talent Scholarship (JTS)
- iii) Jayantian Upliftment Scholarship (JUS)

General Guidelines

1. KJSS is applicable to under-graduate students only.
2. Students who satisfy the stipulated conditions of the schemes are eligible under KJSS and may apply by filling the application form and submitting the form along with supporting documents within the due date.
3. Students who would qualify under category iii (JUS) are eligible to apply for scholarships under category (i) & (ii) also provided they fulfill the conditions.
4. A committee will scrutinize the forms and the Principal will approve the beneficiaries.
5. The decision of the committee in identifying the beneficiaries will be final.
6. The scholarships will be provided at the end of the academic year during a special function
7. The number of scholarships and the amount to be disbursed each year will be decided by the Management of the College.
8. The minimum conditions for applying for scholarship does not guarantee the award of scholarship.
9. The scholarships will not be disbursed if there are no eligible students

1. Jayantian Achievement Scholarship (JAS)

Conditions

- 1.1 This scholarship is exclusively awarded for students who are excellent in academics
- 1.2 Students' academic excellence will be evaluated each semester on a continuous basis and students will be selected for this scholarship after evaluation of performance in the previous Semesters.
- 1.3 Students should have minimum 85% of attendance in each course in the previous semester(s)
- 1.4 B.Com./BBA/B.Sc./BCA students should secure minimum 80% of marks aggregate (CIE & End Semester Examinations) and BA – 75%.
- 1.5 The scholarship amount is Rs. 10000/-

2. Jayantian Talent Scholarship (JTS)

Conditions

- 2.1 This scholarship is provided for encouraging students who excel in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities (Literary & Cultural, Sports & Games and any other special / unique achievement)
- 2.2 Students should have minimum 85% of attendance in each course in the previous semester(s)
- 2.3 Students should secure minimum 60% of marks (aggregate of CIE & End Semester Examinations) and should have passed in all the courses in the previous semester(s)
- 2.4 Students should have represented the college and won a prize at the Inter-University level/State Level / National level competitions.
- 2.5 The scholarship amount is Rs. 10000/-

3. Jayantian Upliftment Scholarship (JUS)

Conditions

- 3.1 This scholarship is provided to financially disadvantaged students
- 3.2 The annual family income of the applicant should be less than Rupees Two Lakhs
- 3.3 Applicants should have secured minimum 60% of marks (aggregate of CIE & End Semester Examinations) and should have passed in all the courses in the previous semester(s)
- 3.4 Applicants should have minimum 85% of attendance in each course in the previous semester(s)
- 3.5 A committee will scrutinize the application after an interview with the applicant where he / she has to justify the need for scholarship
- 3.6 Applicants have to produce a certificate pertaining to proof of income given by the local civic authority
